Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, 'I hat so much of the fourth section of the act of eighteen hundred and forty-two chapter one hundred and eighty-eight, which enacts "that the bailiffs and crier of Prince George's County Court and Courts of Equity, shall receive the same pay and allowance for travelling, which are by this act to jurors, &c.," be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as it refers to the crier of the Circuit Court of Prince George's county.
