Passed May AN ACT entitled, an Act to regulate the Sessions 10, 1852. of the Circuit Courts in the Fourth Judicial Circuit.

Three regufor Allegany county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly lar law terms of Maryland, That there shall be three regular common law terms of the Circuit Court for Allegany county, commencing on the second Monday of April, second Monday of October, and first Monday of January, in in each and every year.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That there shall be three lar law terms regular common law terms of the Circuit Court for Washing-Washington county, commencing on the first Monday of March, fourth Monday of July, and fourth Monday of November, in each and every year.
