SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That at the next general
 election for delegates, and at each general election for
 delegates in every second year thereafter, there shall be
 elected for the several election districts, in each county,
 in this State, by the legal and qualified voters thereof,
 respectively, the following number of justices of the
 peace and constables; that is to say : In Saint Mary's
 St. Mary's co. county : for election district number one, two justices
 of the peace and two constables; for election district
 number two, three justices of the peace and two con-
 stables; for election district number three, three justices
 of the peace and three constables; for election district
 number four, three justices of the peace and two con-
 stables; for election district number five, two justices
 of the peace, and two constables; In Charles county :
 Charles co. for election district number one, four justices of the
 peace and three constables; for election district num-
 ber two, four justices of the peace and four constables;
 for election district number three, four justices of the
 peace and three constables; for election district number
 four, four justices of the peace and three constables;
