CHAP. 35.

AN ACT to regulate the time of holding the Circuit Courts in the Eighth Judicial Circuit. Passed Feb. 25, 1852.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That there shall be four terms of the Circuit Courts in each year, in the several counties composing the eighth Judicial Circuit. Four terms.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the terms of the Circuit Court of Somerset county, shall commence on the first Tuesday in each of the months of January, April, July and October; the terms of the said court for Dorchester county, shall commence on the fourth Tuesday in each of the months of January, April and July, and on the third Tuesday in October; the terms of the said court for Worcester county, shall commence on the third Tuesday in each of the months of February, May, August and November. Terms to commence.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That to the spring and fall terms of the said courts in the several counties of the said circuit, the Sheriffs of the several counties composing the said circuit shall summon and return, according to the requisitions of existing laws, a panel of persons qualified according to law, to serve as Jurors at the said terms. Sheriff to summon jurors.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the Judge of the said courts shall have power and authority to pass all such rules as shall be necessary to facilitate the transaction of business in the said courts; Provided, however, that such rules shall provide for the transaction of equity business, and the said court for equity business shall be considered to be always open. The judge to pass rules. Proviso.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall be in force from the passage thereof. In force.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to change the name of Edward Buchanan Baltzell to Edward Baltzell Buchanan. Passed March 1, 1852.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name of Edward Buchanan Baltzell, of Frederick county, and State of Maryland, Name changed.
