CHAPTER 304.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Baltimore, Carroll and Frederick Railroad Company. Passed May 27, 1852.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That George Brown, Robert M. Magraw, Zenus Barnum, William F. Johnson, Charles Painter, Richard Green, Richard Worthington, Nicholas Kelly, Edward Remington, Jacob Reese, John Fisher, Jacob Mathias, David Roop, Joshua Smith, J. Henry Hoppe, David H. Shriver, John Smith, Samuel Ecker, Joseph Moore, Reuben Haines, of W., Daniel P. Saylor, John Cover, Peragrine Fitzhugh, Joshua Motter, Robert Annan, David Rinehart, Jervis Spencer, Isaac Motter, and John Baker, or any five of them, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things hereinafter mentioned, that is to say: they shall on or before the first day of December next, procure books, and therein enter, as follows: We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president and directors of the Baltimore, Carroll and Frederick Railroad Company, the sum of fifty dollars for every share of stock set opposite our respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such simes, as shall be determined by the president and directors of said company, or a majority of them, in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore, Carroll and Frederick Railroad company. Witness our hands, this day of , in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty ; and shall thereupon give notice in one or more papers, published in the counties through which said railroad may pass, for three weeks at least, of the times and places, when and where the said books shall be kept open to receive subscriptions for the stock of said company, at which respective times and places, one or more of the commissioners shall attend, and permit all persons of lawful age, who shall offer to subscribe in the said books, in their own names, or name of any other person who shall authorize the same, for any number of shares in the said
