No person to Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That no person or persons, who may keep a store or tavern, shall give credit to any student of St. Timothy's Hall, being a minor, or sell or furnish to any such student any spirtuous liquor, knowing them to be such student or students, within the distance of two and a half miles from said institution, without the consent, in writing, of the rector of said institution, or such other officer, or officers, as may be authorized by the government thereof to act in such cases.

Forfeiture for violation.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That if any person, or persons, shall violate any of the provisions of this act, he, she or they, upon conviction, shall forfeit and pay to the commissioners of Baltimore county, for the use of the public schools of said county, a sum not less than one dollar or more than five dollars, to be recovered before any justice of the peace, in Baltimore county, as small debts are now recovered.
