laborer the amount so due him for such labor, and an CHAP, 326, action may be maintained against said company therefor; such notice shall be given by said laborer to said company, within twenty days after the performance of the number of days labor for which the claim is made; such notice shall be in writing, and shall state the amount and number of days labor, and the time when the same was performed for which the claim is made, and the name of the contractor from whom due, and shall be signed by said laborer or his attorney, and shall be served on an engineer, agent or superintendent employed by said company, having charge of the section of the road on which such labor was performed, personally, or by leaving the same at the office or usual place of business of such engineer, agent or superintendent, or with some person of suitable age, but no action shall be maintained against said company under the provisions of this section, unless the same is commenced within thirty days after notice is given to the company, by such laborer as above provided.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That the president Powers of preand directors shall have power to lay off and construct sident and dia rail road, not exceeding eighty feet in width, with gard to conone or more sets of tracks, from the city of Baltimore, struction of to some point on the Pennsylvania line, between Cono-road. wingo creek, and Little Elk creek, crossing the Susquenanna river, at or between Conowingo and Port Deposit, so as to connect with a contemplated rail road in the State of Pennsylvania, from Philadelphia to the Maryland line, and for the purpose of laying off and constructing the said road, they shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the restrictions and liabilities hereinafter described, and they may take the route which, to them, may seem most suitable and
