SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Time changof Maryland, That the next election of Representatives ed. of this State in the Congress of the United States, shall be on the first Wednesday of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, and on the same day in every second year thereafter, unless there should be a special meeting of Congress, called by the President of the United States, to be holden previous to such day, and after the expiration of the term of service of said representatives, in which event the Governor of Maryland shall, by proclamation, direct such election to be held on a day therein named by him, which said proclamation shall require at least twenty days notice of each election to be given by the sheriffs of the respective counties and city of Baltimore.
