SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That so much of the fifth section of the act entitled, an act to divide the State into six representative districts, passed December session, eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter sixteen, as fixes the first Wednesday in October as the day for electing representatives to Congress, be, and the same is hereby repealed. Fifth sec. of act of 1843, ch. 16, repealed.

**CHAPTER 53.**

*AN ACT* entitled, *an Act appropriating the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to meet the Deficiencies of the Contingent Fund, for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.* Passed March 19, 1852.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of two thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated to pay the contingent expenses of the State incurred, due and unpaid, for the year eighteen hundred and fifty-one, and the Treasurer is hereby directed and required to pay, upon the warrants of the Comptroller, the orders of the Executive, for any sum or sums not exceeding two thousand dollars, out of any unappropriated monies in the Treasury. Sum appropriated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

**CHAPTER 54.**

*AN ACT* entitled, *an act to authorise the Commissioners of Prince George's County, to levy a sum of money sufficient to repair and furnish the Court House of said County.* Passed March 22, 1852.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of Prince George's county, be and they are hereby authorised to Levy authorized.
