Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Commissioners appointed of Maryland, That Thomas J. Rusk, Sterling Thomas to make sale. and Joseph Haines, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to make sale of the lot or parcel of land on which the live stock scales in the city of Baltimore are situated; and the said commissioners are hereby required to give at least three weeks notice of said sale, in some newspaper published in Baltimore city; and they shall sell said parcel of land for cash, or partly for cash and partly on credit, at public sale, as in their judgment may seem most advantageous, and upon the payment of the purchase money, said commissioners are hereby authorised to convey by good and sufficient deed, said land, to the purchaser or purchasers thereof.
