

fees, and the mode of their collections are set forth and provided for. **CHAP. 858.**

The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-one, chapter twenty-two, entitled, an act to regulate public ferries, and the supplements thereto, passed respectively, to wit:

At April session, seventeen hundred and eighty-two, chapter thirty-one, entitled, a supplement to the act to regulate public ferries; **Act of 1781, chapter 22.**

At November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-eight, chapter thirty-three, entitled, an additional supplement to the act to regulate public ferries; **Act of 1783, chapter 31.**

At November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-one, chapter sixty-five, entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate public ferries; **Act of 1788, chapter 33.**

At November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-nine, chapter eighty-three, entitled, an additional supplementary act to the act to regulate public ferries, whereby provision is made for the establishment of, and regulation of public ferries in this State. **Act of 1791, chapter 65.**

The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-seven, chapter nine, entitled, an act respecting the continuance of civil suits in the general and county courts, and the supplement thereto, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-four, chapter six, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act respecting the continuance of civil suits in the general and counties' courts, which supplement provides for the continuance of civil suits under certain circumstances. **Act of 1799, chapter 83.**

The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-one, chapter sixty-eight, entitled, an act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of Assembly therein mentioned, which provides for, and regulates the recovery of small debts. **Act of 1787, chapter 9.**

The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-three, chapter seventy-five, entitled, an act relative to appeals to be prosecuted, or injunctions to be obtained by executors or administrators, and relating to injunctions, writs of errors, penalty and surety of bonds, and jurisdiction of Chancellor, and so forth. **Act of 1791, chapter 68.**

The act entitled, an act for the more effectual collection of county charges, in the several counties of this State, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter ninety, and giving certain powers to commissioners of tax, now styled County **Act of 1793, chapter 75.**
