CHAP. 358. Commissioners, whereby taxes may be more effectually collected.

Act of 1798, chapter 101.

The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-eight, chapter one hundred and one, entitled, an act for amending and reducing into system the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, administrators and guardians, and the rights of orphans and other representatives of deceased persons, whereby the duties and jurisdiction of the Orphans' court, and registers of wills of this State, and the settlement of deceased person's estates, are regulated and provided for.

Act of 1829. A supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, chapter two hundred and twenty-three.

Act of 1833, An act entitled, a further supplement to the acts of Assembly, regulating the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore, passed eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter two hundred and twenty-eight;

Act of 1834. An act entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eight teen hundred and thirty-four, chapter one hundred and ninety-eight;
