

CHAP. 358. Commissioners, whereby taxes may be more effectually collected.

Act of 1798,
chapter 101. The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-eight, chapter one hundred and one, entitled, an act for amending and reducing into system the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, administrators and guardians, and the rights of orphans and other representatives of deceased persons, whereby the duties and jurisdiction of the Orphans' court, and registers of wills of this State, and the settlement of deceased person's estates, are regulated and provided for.

Act of 1801,
chapter 63. The act passed at November session, eighteen hundred and one, chapter sixty-three, entitled, an act to regulate the inspective of tobacco, and the supplements thereto, passed respectively, and entitled, as follows:

Act of 1804,
chapter 85. A further supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and four, chapter eighty-five;

Act of 1820,
chapter 188. An additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty, chapter one hundred and eighty-eight;

Act of 1821,
chapter 194. A further supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty-one, chapter one hundred and ninety-four;

Act of 1822,
chapter 173. An additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty-two, chapter one hundred and seventy-two;

Act of 1828,
chapter 164. A further additional supplement to an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, chapter one hundred and sixty-four;

Act of 1829,
chapter 223. A supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, chapter two hundred and twenty-three.

Act of 1833,
chapter 228. An act entitled, a further supplement to the acts of Assembly, regulating the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore, passed eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter two hundred and twenty-eight;

Act of 1834,
chapter 198. An act entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, passed eight hundred and thirty-four, chapter one hundred and ninety-eight;

Act of 1835,
chapter 123. An act entitled, an act entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish State warehouses
