Act of 1799, chapter 58. The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-nine, chapter fifty-eight, entitled, an act to provide for the administration of justice in cases of crimes and misdemeanors in the city and county of Baltimore.

Act of 1774, chapter 23. The act passed at March session, seventeen hundred and seventy-four, chapter twenty-three, entitled, an act for the regulating the guaging of casks in the town of Baltimore.

Act of 1804, chapter 96. The act passed at the session of eighteen hundred and four, chapter ninety-six, entitled, an act relating to vagrants in the city of Baltimore.

Act of 1785, chapter 87. The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-five, chapter eighty-seven, entitled, an act concerning jurisdiction, which gave to justices of county courts jurisdiction in criminal cases;
