## **CHAPTER 360.**

Passed May AN ACT to Revive and make Perpetual, certain 31, 1852. Expired Laws, or Laws limited in their Duration.

Acts revived, Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following named Acts of Assembly, or such parts of them respectively as would now be applicable, and have not been repealed, to wit:

Act of 1778, The act passed at October session, seventeen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter twenty-one, entitled, an act for amending and declaring the law in the cases therein mentioned, and relating to the validity of verdicts in certain cases, the form of recognizance of bail, and other proceedings, powers, and regulations of, and in certain courts.

Act of 1779, The act passed at July session, seventeen hundred seventy-nine, chapter eight, entitled, an act establishing a mode to perpetuate testimony, whereby parties were authorised to take deposition of witnesses, as is therein set forth, and to be used as therein provided.

Act of 1779, The act passed at November session, seventeen hunchapter 25. dred and seventy-nine, chapter twenty-five, entitled, an act for the regulation of officers fees, whereby officers fees and the mode of their collection are set forth and provided for.

Act of 1781, The act passed at November session, seventeen hundred and eighty one, chapter twenty-two, entitled, an act to regulate public ferries, and the supplements thereto, passed respectively, to wit:

Act of 1782, At April session, seventeen hundred and eighty two, chapter 31. chapter thirty-one, entitled, a supplement to the act to regulate public ferries;

Act of 1788, At November session, seventeen hundred and eighty-chapter 33. eight, chapter thirty three, entitled, an additional supplement to the act to regulate public ferries;

Act of 1791, At November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-chapter 65. one, chapter sixty-five, entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate public ferries;

Act of 1799, At November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-nine, chapter eighty-three, entitled, an additional supplementary act to the act to regulate public ferries, whereby provision is made for the establishment of, and regulation of public ferries in this State. E. I
