SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That any party feeling Right of apaggrieved by any final decision of the Commissioner peal. of the Land Office, in his action or proceedings under this law, upon stating, in writing, the ground of his grievance, detailing fully the particulars thereof, and filing the same, in writing, in the Land Office, within thirty days after such decision, may within nine months from the date of the decision of said commissioner, appeal therefrom to the Court of Appeals, and thereupon it shall be the duty of the said commissioner to send up a transcript of the record within two months after such appeal shall be taken or ordered; the party appealing to give bond to the State of Maryland, in the usual form of appeal bonds, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned to indemnify the party or parties interested in said land, from all loss or injury consequent upon the appeal, which Court of Appeals shall hear and dispose of the said appeal at the first term, if practicable.
