

CHAP. 67. at the session of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter four hundred and two, as authorises the Levy Court, of Caroline county, to appoint the trustees of the poor to serve for seven years from the time of their appointment, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Time to appoint. **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That hereafter the County Commissioners of the said county, shall appoint the said trustees in the month of April of each and every year.

Take effect 10th of April. **SEC. 3.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the tenth day of April, eighteen hundred and fifty-two; and that all appointments of said trustees, prior thereto, shall be vacated.

CHAPTER 67.

Passed April 7, 1852. **AN ACT** to prescribe what shall be evidence in suits instituted for the recovery of money belonging to this State.

Evidence of debt. **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in case of the institution in the courts of this State, of any suit or action against a Collector or other officer, charged with the collection or receipt of monies belonging to the State, or against the official bond of such Collector or other officer, a statement of the account of such Collector or other officer, certified and signed by the Comptroller of the treasury department, shall be taken and received as prima facie evidence of the debt or amount therein stated to be due.

In force. **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the passage thereof.
