

66. An act to repeal a part of the act entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Caroline county to appoint the trustees of the poor of said county, and to require the appointment of said trustees annually.

67. An act entitled, an act to prescribe what shall be evidence in suits instituted for the recovery of money belonging to this State.

68. An act entitled, an act to provide for carrying into effect the twenty-second section of the fourth article of the Constitution.

69. An act entitled, an act to repeal the charter of the Washington Coal company, created by an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter two hundred and fifty-five.

70. An act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Boston Steam Navigation company.

71. An act entitled, an act for repairing and furnishing the Government House.

72. An act entitled, an act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the reward offered by the Governor, for the apprehension and conviction of the murderers of William Cosden and others.

73. An act entitled, an act to regulate the meetings of the Orphans' court of Howard county, and the compensation of the judges thereof.

74. An act entitled, an act to make valid certain acts of the clerk of the Circuit court of Dorchester county.

75. An act entitled, an act to authorise and empower the Circuit courts and Circuit judges to extend the time of sheriffs and collectors, and of those succeeding them, to complete their collections.

76. An act entitled, an act prescribing the process in civil actions in the courts and before the justices of the peace.

77. An act to authorise appeals from the decision of the Criminal court of Baltimore, in relation to streets.

78. An act entitled, an act to amend the charter of Bel-Air turnpike company.

79. An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Worcester county, to be called Saint Martin's, or number ten district.

80. An act to provide for repairing the treasury buildings, and for rendering the same and the vault therein fire-proof.

81. An act to allow a pension to Eleanora B. Watkins, widow of the late Colonel Gassaway Watkins, a captain in the revolution, and appropriating a sum of money for the payment thereof.
