115. An act to authorise and empower the commissioners of Washington county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Little Antietum creek, on the old road leading from Sharpsburg to Middletown, and near the house of Josiah and Elias Snively.

116. An act to change the time of holding elections for certain officers for the almshouse in Talbot county, and to repeal so much of the act passed 1785, chapter 15, section 10, as fixes the time of holding said elections between the 1st and 10th day of November yearly.

117. An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Dorchester county, out of parts of the fourth and seventh election districts in said county, to be called Church creek district, or dis-

trict number nine.
