

129. An act entitled, a supplement to an act for the preservation and repair of that part of the United States road lying within the limits of Maryland, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 65.

130. An act to refund to Rev'd Nicholas I. Watkins, thirty-two dollars and seventy-three cents, being the amount overpaid the State by said Watkins for State taxes.

131. An act to incorporate the Merchant's Exchange company of Baltimore.

132. An act to allow to the Susquehanna and Tide Water Canal companies to fund their debt and issue additional stock.

133. An act to provide that the answers of defendants in proceedings in equity shall not be evidence against complainants, unless such answers be required by the complainants to be under oath.

134. An act to require advertisements proceeding from the courts and officers of Baltimore county to be published in one paper printed in the said county.

135. An act appropriating a sum of money to pay for repairs made in and materials furnished for the Senate chamber.

136. An act to make valid all judgments rendered by any of the district courts of this State since the adoption of the new constitution.

137. An act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance company of Anne Arundel county.

138. An act relating to sales by public auction in the town of Elkton and the other incorporated towns in Cecil county.

139. An act to fix the per diem of the judges of the Orphans' court of Baltimore city, and of the judges of the Orphans' court of Baltimore county, pursuant to the seventeenth section of the fourth article of the constitution.

140. An act requiring judges of the first judicial circuit of Maryland to suppress the retailing of ardent spirits in the village of Charlotte Hall, and within two miles thereof, upon the recommendation of a majority of the trustees of Charlotte Hall academy.

141. An act to authorise the mayor and city council of Baltimore to aid in the construction of a rail road from the terminus of the York and Cumberland road, at Bridgeport, to Sunbury and Williamsport on the Susquehanna.

142. An act to authorise the commissioner of the land office to issue a warrant of resurvey and patent for certain lands in Allegany county.

143. An act to amend an act entitled, an act to incorporate the proprietors of Baltimore Cemetery, passed at December session 1849, chapter 71, granting power to said company to convey certain portions of their grounds, and to increase its capital stock.

144. An act to authorise the county commissioners of Frederick county, in their discretion, from time to time, to appoint road commissioners to examine and report upon the best means of im-
