165. An act to make valid a deed from Charles H. Carroll, of the State of New York, executor of the last will and testament of Charles Carroll, deceased, to James Reynolds, of Montgomery county.

166. An act to cure a defect in the acknowledgment of a deed from John Richardson and wife, of the State of Indiana, to Sydnium H. Mills, of Worcester county.

167. An act to amend the charter of the President and directors of the Associated Firemen's Insurance Company of Baltimore.

168. An act for the better regulation of primary schools in Carroll county.

169. An act to provide for payment of expenses occasioned by the removal of civil cases.

170. An act authorising the Orphans' court of Worcester county to complete the record of proceedings of the late Orphans' court of said county.

171. An act to provide for laying out into avenues, streets, lanes and alleys, and public reservations, the Western Liberties of Baltimore county.

172. An act to designate the persons before whom oaths of office shall be taken and subscribed.

173. An act to authorise the clerks of courts to make orders and to issue commissions in equity cases, and to adjourn court in certain cases.

174. An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Dorchester county, to be called district number ten, or Strait's Neck district.

175. An act to incorporate a Literary Institution at Hagerstown, in Washington county, to be styled the Hagerstown Female Seminary.

176. An act for the correction of misnomers in criminal cases.

177. An act for amending proceedings in actions at law.

178. An act to refund to John Rawlings, late collector of tax in Cecil county, an overpayment made by him into the treasury.

179. An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of Andrew Slicer and William Glover.

180. An act to make valid the acts of Judges in holding sessions of courts without express provisions of law, and to declare the effect of process irregularly issued therefrom.

181. An act to authorise John Stump to erect a fishing battery on the shores of the Susquehanna river adjoining his lands in Cecil county.

182. An act to incorporate the town of Sharpsburg and Miller's Addition to Sharpsburgh.

183. An act pursuant to the sixth section of the tenth article of the constitution, relative to Judges of Election.
