

220. An act to extend the time of certain collectors to complete their collections.

221. An act to incorporate Cemetery companies.

222. An act to change the place of holding elections in election district number three, or the lower election district of Caroline county.

223. An act to create a new election district in Washington county.

224. An act to purchase copies of the Maryland Chancery reports for the use of the courts of each county, and for the benefit of the State Library.

225. An act entitled, an act regulating the fees of Sheriffs of Allegany county, for taking prisoners from the county jail to the State's prison.

226. An act to provide for the collection of State and county taxes in arrears in Baltimore county.

227. An act for the completion of the unfinished business of Baltimore county court as a court of equity, so far as the same relates to the city of Baltimore.

228. An act to authorise the commissioners of Baltimore county to levy on said county a sum sufficient to pay the additional expenses incurred in holding the second inquisition over the body of Joseph C. Miller, late of Pennsylvania.

229. An act to amend an act entitled, act for the protection of miners, mechanics, laborers and others employed in mines and manufactories in the county of Allegany, and for other purposes, passed December session, 1847, chapter 228.

230. An act to lay off and locate a public road in Howard county.

231. An act to provide for the formation of corporations for moral, scientific, literary, dramatic, agricultural, or charitable purposes, and for the incorporation of uniformed volunteer companies, fire engine or hose companies, and benevolent, beneficial and musical associations.

232. An act to authorise and empower Nathaniel Wiley and John W. Bowman, of Kent county, to sell and dispose of a tract or parcel of land in said county, and the proceeds to be applied towards building a church in said county.

233. An act to authorise the county commissioners of Talbot, Queen Anne's and Caroline counties to levy a sum for paying the crier of the Circuit court in said counties.

234. An act making valid certain proceedings of Absalom W. Sparks, late a constable of Kent county, and authorising a deed of certain lands therein mentioned, to be made to William Lamb.

235. An act to prevent the circulation of notes or bills of a denomination less than five dollars.

236. An act for the relief Henry Snurr, Jr., of Frederick county.

237. An act incorporating a company to make the Bloomingdale Turnpike Road on the bed of the present road, leading from
