

251. An act to provide for the removal of certain cases from the Superior court of Baltimore city to the Court of Common Pleas.

252. An act to pay to William Thompson, late sheriff of Montgomery county, an amount due him for fees, by the State of Maryland.

253. An act authorising the payment to James Fields of a sum of money due him as interest by the State.

254. An act appropriating a sum of money to pay John M. Davis, of Annapolis, for materials furnished and work done to the room of the Court of Appeals.

255. An act to prevent merger on the mortgage of leasehold estates to the owners of the reversion.

256. An act to make valid the official acts of James McAnally, a constable in and for Allegany county.

257. An act to authorise the treasurer of the Nanticoke Bridge Company to pay to the directors of said company the dividends due the State, to be appropriated towards repairing said bridge.

258. An act to establish a new election district in Talbot county.

259. An act to construct a bridge across Drummond's Branch, in the seventh election district in Worcester county.

260. An act to authorise the payment to James C. Davis of the sum of money overpaid by him as State tax.

261. An act to erect a new election district in Frederick county, out of parts of number three and number six election districts.

262. An act, entitled, an act to provide for the payment to Samuel F. Stonestreet, late clerk of Montgomery county court, for fees due him from the State.

263. An act to provide for carrying into effect the fifth section of the fourth article of the constitution.

264. An act to establish a new school district, out of part of primary school district, number twenty-nine, of Howard county.

265. An act for the benefit of the owners of the steamboat Osiris.

266. An act to authorise and empower the president, managers and company of the Boonsborough Turnpike Road Company to grade, occupy and change, if necessary, the public road leading from Sharpsburg to the Potomac river, and to charge toll thereon.
