CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT to alter and change the name of *Richard Tillard*, to *Richard Tillard Estep*.

Name changed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the name of Richard Tillard, a native of the State of Maryland, and now a resident therein, be and the same is hereby altered and changed to Richard Tillard Estep, and it shall be lawful for the said Richard Tillard, at all times hereafter to be called and known by, and hold and use the name of Richard Tillard Estep, and by the name of Richard Tillard Estep, to purchase, sell, convey or devise, to sue and be sued, in any court of law and equity.

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT to establish the location of *Water Street* in the *City of Cumberland*, and to grade the same.

Commissioners appointed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Thomas Shriver, Daniel Blocher and Horace Resley, or any two of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to establish the location of *Water street*, from the western abutment of the bridge across *Wills creek*, on *Washington street* to *Green street* in the city of *Cumberland*, with full power and authority to change the position or site of the same, by
