SEC. 10. And be it enacted, That it shall be the Notice of duty of the trustees of each school district, after they election. have been organized, annually to give ten days notice in writing before each annual election for trustees, set up at some public place, of the time and place of holding such election, and if for any reason an election should not take place on the day notified, they shall give a further notice till an election is effected, and the old trustees shall hold their office till their successors are appointed, and nothing in this act shall be so construed as to prevent the school commissioners from acting as trustees, if elected as such.
