AN ACT to alter and amend the charter of the Hagers- Passed Mar. 8, 1854 town Savings Institution.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Repeated. of Maryland, That so much of the first section of the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter two hundred and sixty-six, as requires the Hagerstown Savings Institution to be known and called by the name and style of the Hagerstown Savings Institution, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that the said corporation shall hereafter be known and called by the name and style of the Hagerstown Savings Name. Bank, with power and authority by that name to have, exercise, hold, enjoy, use and possess, all the rights, privileges and immunities that are prescribed and granted by the said act incorporating the Hagerstown Savings Institution, passed at December session, as aforesaid.

SEC. 2.
