- Act in force until 1880.** SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall be and continue in force until January the first eighteen hundred and eighty, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly, which shall happen thereafter.
- Reservation.** SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature reserves the right to alter and amend, or repeal this act at pleasure.
- In force.** SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 121.

- Passed Mar. 9, 1854.** AN ACT to change the place of holding the elections in the sixth election district of Prince George's county.
- Place changed** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the place for holding elections in the sixth election district of Prince George's county be, and the same is hereby changed, and all elections to be hereafter held in said election districts shall be held in the house now occupied by Jesse Ridgaway, on the main road near the present place of holding elections.

CHAPTER 122.

- Passed Mar. 9, 1854.** AN ACT amendatory of the act to incorporate the South Baltimore company, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter ninety-six, and to extend the duration of said act to January first, eighteen hundred and eighty, and to appoint additional corporators, and to increase the capital stock
