Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be lawful for the citizens eatch oysters Lawful to of Somerset county, to take or catch oysters with a with scoop or scoop or diag in any of the waters of said county, not parcel of any creek or river, not within two hundred yards distance from the shore, and in waters not less than twenty-one feet deep.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Sometset clerk to issue county, upon the application of any citizen of said license. county, to issue a license to such citizen, authorising him to take and catch oysters, with scoops or drags, in the waters of said county, subject to the provisions of this act, for one year from the date of said license, for which the person or persons so applying shall pay to said clerk the sum of fifteen dollars; Provided, that the person so applying for a license shall be first required to make oath, that he is a bona fide owner of the vessel to be licensed, that he has been a bona fide citizen of the State for one year immediately preceding said application, and six months a resident of the county, and that the license is intended for his use only.
