

## CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT to authorise an addition to the primary school House in Bladensburg, in Prince George's county, and the employment of an additional teacher therein. Passed  
Mar. 9, 1854.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Thomas Clements, Robert Wright and William B. Galer, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or majority of them are authorised and empowered to contract for and superintend the erection of an addition to the primary school house in Bladensburg primary school district in Prince George's county; *Provided,* the entire cost of said addition shall not exceed the sum of two hundred dollars. Commission-

Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That when the addition to the said school house shall have been erected the general board of trustees of primary schools for said county are hereby authorised to employ a teacher therein until the local board of trustees shall be elected by the patrons and tax payers of said school district as is now required by law. Employment  
of teacher.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That when the said commissioners shall present to the county commissioners of Prince George's county, under oath the cost of the erection of the addition to said school house, that the county commissioners are hereby authorised to levy upon the assessable property of said county at their first levy laying term thereafter a sum of money sufficient to defray the cost of the addition to said school house and payable to the said commissioners or their order. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the teacher employed in said school shall receive the same compensation as is allowed the teachers in the primary schools in said county, and to be paid in the manner already provided by law. Compensation

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
