Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Kent county be, and they are hereby authorised and required, at their meeting on the second Monday of April next, and in each succeeding year thereafter, to appoint three discreet and proper persons, qualified agreeably to the provisions of the original act, one of whom shall be taken from the first election district, one from the second election district, and one from the third election district, to be trustees of the poor of said county.
