SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Washington county railroad company, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to locate and construct a railroad from Hagerstown to any point on the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal on the Potomac river within the limits of Washington county, in addition to the road or roads authorised by the above act.
