SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated. of Maryland, That John Neff, John C. Wise, James H. Hoblitzell, Jeremiah S. Welsh, James M. Porter, Charles H. Hammill and Michael Halfin, and all others, who shall become members of the Frostburg Savings Bank in the manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be, and they are hereby made and created, a body politic and corporate, by the name and style of the Frostburg Savings Bank, and by that name shall have succession and be capable in law to hold and dispose of property, to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, defend and be defended, in any court of law or of equity, to receive and make all deeds, contracts, transfers, conveyances and grants, whatsover, to make, have, and use a common seal, and the same to alter and renew at pleasure, and generally to do every other act or thing necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this act.
