SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sureties on the official bonds of William Lyles of Thomas, former collector for the third collection district of Prince George's county, be, and they are hereby released from the payment of interest on the State's claims against said Lyles; Provided. That the amount due for principal on said claims, in the suit or suits now pending against said bonds in the circuit court for Prince George's county, with the cost, shall be paid as follows: one-third thereof on or before the first day of November next, one-third on or before the first day of April eighteen hundred and fiftyfive, and the residue on or before the first day of November thereafter, upon the adjustment of said claims by the Comptroller; Provided however, that said sureties shall not be released from the payment of such interest as has been received by the said collector or his sureties nor for such as may be due by the tax payers on the taxes now due by them, nor from the interest accruing on the principal from the passage of this act.
