SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the present trustees Competent to and their successors, shall by their corporate name be persons able and capable in law to purchase, take, have and enjoy to them and their successors in fee or less estate, any lands, tenements, rents, annuities, chattles or public securities within this State, and the same at their pleasure to transfer, sell, lease or alter in such manner as they may deem most condusive to the interest of the said corporation; Provided, that the said Proviso. corporation shall not at any one time hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in total value the sum of five thousand dollars.
