

the publication of the receipts and expenditures of the county commissioners for Somerset county, be, and the same is hereby so modified, as to require a publication of the several and particular items of receipts and expenditures annually, in regular and alphabetical order, once in each of three consecutive weeks, in some newspaper printed in said county; *Provided*, there be one there printed, and that said publication shall include the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three, as well as the years following.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all sales of lands or negroes, or personal property, that shall amount to four hundred dollars or over, made by order of the orphan's court of Somerset county, be, and the same are hereby required to be published in some newspaper printed as aforesaid.

Sales of land, &c. required to be published.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the act of eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter one hundred and twenty-three, and the act of eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and eight, regulating the price of printing public advertisements in Somerset county, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Acts repealed.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT authorising the orphans court of Charles county to appoint commissioners to divide primary school district, number three, and six of the third election district of Charles county, and create a new school district therein.
