## CHAPTER 224.

AN ACT to make additional provision for the instruction of Indigent Blind persons, inhabitants of this Mar. 10, 1854. State.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Sum increasof Maryland, That the sum annually appropriated for the instruction of indigent blind persons in and by the first section of the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter two hundred and nine, entitled an act to provide for the instruction of indigent blind persons, inhabitants of this State, be and the same is hereby increased to not exceeding four thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Governor of Authority of Maryland whenever he shall be satisfied that the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the blind is prepared to educate blind persons, be, and he is hereby authorised to place or have placed in the said institution for education such indigent blind persons as shall thereafter be educated at the expense of the State or such and so many of them as he may deem expedient. on a record and noon with her brooms and entatoxe
