

CHAPTER 239.

AN ACT authorising the county commissioners of Howard county, to compensate Henry McDade, for the loss of his slave killed, while struggling to preserve the peace of the State.

Passed
Mar. 10, 1854.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Authority to levy.
That the county commissioners of Howard county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to levy on the assessable property of Howard county, the sum of five hundred dollars, towards satisfying Henry McDade, a poor man, for the loss of his only slave, who was killed in endeavoring to preserve the peace, and separate combatants, who were disturbing the order and quiet of the State.

CHAPTER 240.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the payment of John Palmer.

Passed
Mar. 10, 1854.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Authority to pay.
That the Treasurer is hereby required on the warrant of the Comptroller to pay to John Palmer, or his order, three dollars and eighty-six cents, being the amount due him as clerk of the circuit court for Queen Anne's county, by the State of Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* In force.
That this act shall take effect from its passage.
