

CHAPTER 267.

AN ACT to pay to Elizabeth Rich a sum of money due her mother, Priscilla Connelly.

Passed Mar. 10, 1854,

WHEREAS, Priscilla Connelly, late of Worcester county, deceased, was in her life time in receipt of a pension from the State of Maryland, on account of services rendered by her husband, William Connelly, a private in the war of the revolution, and at the time of her death there was due the said Priscilla Connelly a balance for one year, one month and ten days; Therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Elizabeth Rich, the only surviving child and representative of Priscilla Connelly, be, and she is hereby entitled to receive the amount due her said mother.

Entitled to receive amount due.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the treasurer of Maryland, on the warrant of the comptroller, be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Elizabeth Rich, or order, the sum of forty-four dollars and forty-five cents, the amount of pension due.

Authority to pay.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall be in force from and after the date of its passage.

In force.
