Joice, are the owners of a large body of mineral land lying on Winebraners' Run, in Allegany county, containing extensive beds of coal and iron ore, and that the trade and business of the great works of internal improvements of the State will be greatly promoted by opening and working said beds of coal and iron ore, and transporting the same to market : Therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said Thomas J. McKaig, Thomas Chalkley, Atkinson Douglas Percy and R. L.
