

as the collector of the public county assessment has to destrain for the same, and that the said president and commissioners shall fix the term of office, responsibility and compensation of said collector.

Power to appoint bailiff.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority annually to appoint a bailiff, whose duty it shall be to preserve the peace and good order of said town, and for the purposes of said corporation, he is hereby invested with the same power and authority as any constable may now have under the laws of this State.

Repealed.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That any act of incorporation of said town inconsistent with this act, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 288.

Passed Mar. 10, 1854.

AN ACT to alter and amend the act entitled, an act to authorise the Governor of Maryland to appoint an Inspector of Flour for the Town of Cumberland, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter two hundred and ten.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, in consequence of the small quantity of flour to be inspected in Cumberland, and the large tax required to be paid for the commission of a flour inspector, the said town of Cumberland has been deprived of the benefits of such inspection ; Therefore,

Amount to be paid by inspector.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the clerk of the circuit court for Allegany county be and he is hereby authorised to deliver the commission of flour inspector in Cumberland, to the person who may be appointed to that office upon his paying a tax of five dollars for the same, for the use of this State.
