Be it enacted by the General Assembly elect patrol of of Maryland, That the citizens of Newark, Worcester county, be, and they are hereby authorised to elect such police or patrol officer, who shall have full power to summons men to disperse such gatherings, and exercise all the patrol duties in said town that are discharged by the constables of the county.

And be it enacted, That the citizens of said town may, on the first Saturday of March and biennially thereafter, elect one police or patrol officer, to exercise the duties and privileges above named; and said officer shall receive such compensation for his services as the commissioners of said county may allow; said election to be held by one justice of the peace.
