New district.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new election district be formed and established and the same is hereby established in Somerset county, out of part of the first election district in said county to be called and known as Sharptown district or district No. thirteen.

Boundaries.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the boundaries of said new election district shall be as follows to wit: beginning at a place on the Nanticoke river, called Bacon quarter, and running from thence by and with the county road, from said place to Levin Wright's dwelling house on said road, and from thence a due east course until it intersects the Maryland and Delaware line.
