WARRANTS OF RESURVEY—Act regulating, 462 322

Persons entitled to lands in fee simple and being in possession thereof, may obtain a warrant of resurvey from land office; not necessary in such warrant to state name of tracts of land to be resurveyed, and the surveyor to whom such warrant is directed to survey, shall survey the land according to the possession or holding of the same for the last thirty years, and he shall take proof of said possession and holding, " " 1

The surveyor, before he executes such warrants, shall give reasonable notice to the owners and occupiers of adjacent lands, 463 " 2

The surveyor shall return to the land office, within one year from date of warrant, a certificate of survey and plot, with depositions and proof of notice, &c.; and if no caveat or objection be made within six months after such return, a patent shall issue, " " 3
