SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Duty of the Clerk. of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, whenever a judgment is rendered in said court, it shall be the duty of the clerk of said court, to enter upon his index, to be kept for that purpose, the names of all the defendants against whom said judgments have been rendered. sored certagann dide to persugan so yang too
