AN ACT to pay John O. Wharton, of Washington county, certain taxes erroneously paid by him.

Authority to pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay on the warrant of the comptroller, to John O. Wharton, of Washington county, the sum of thirty-four dollars and thirty-seven cents, being the amount of State taxes erroneously paid by him, and the sum of thirty-four dollars and thirty-seven cents be and the same is hereby appropriated for that purpose.

CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to provide for a new Great Seal for this State.

Authority to procure new seal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorised and required to procure a new great seal for this State, the cost of which shall be paid on a certificate of the Governor by the treasurer, on a warrant from the comptroller.

Motto, etc.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the seal to be procured shall contain on its face the arms of the State, as heretofore known and accepted, with the motto, in

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
