Passed Dec. A supplement to an act entitled, " An act to appoint commissioners to grade and level the several squares, streets, lanes, and alleys in the precincts of Baltimore, west of Jones' Falls."

Two thirds of ers petitioning, the commissioners shall give notice, &c.

Sec. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Asproperty hold- sembly of Maryland, That whenever two thirds of the owners of property in the said precincts, shall make application in writing, for the purpose of levelling to the grade established of any street, lane or alley, the commissioners shall give ten days notice of such application in one or more of the newspapers printed in Baltimore, and if after that time the owners of property do not commence to cut down or fill up and complete the same at and within such time as may be allowed by the commissioners, then and in that case, the commissioners are hereby authorised and empowered, to contract on the most reasonable terms, for the cutting down and filling up such street, lane or alley, and charge, levy, assess and collect the cost and expense of the work done on the lots of ground opposite to such cutting down and filling up, agreeably to the number of feet in front of each lot, and according to the quantity of earth cut down or filled up opposite each, as near as the same can be ascertained.
