CHAPTER 142.

An act to repeal an act entitled, An act to change the name of George-Town Cross-Roads in Kent county.

Passed Decr. 24, 1812.

WHEREAS, It has been represented to this General Assembly, by the memorial of sundry inhabitants of Kent county, in the neighbourhood of a village formerly called George-Town Cross-Roads, stating that the name of said village had been changed by an act of the Legislature of Maryland, passed at November session eighteen hundred and eleven, chapter 119, to that of Colchester, to their injury, and praying that the said law may be repealed, and that the said village may retain its former name: Therefore,

Preamble.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act entitled, An act to change the name of George-Town Cross-Roads in Kent county, passed at November session eighteen hundred and eleven, be, and the same is hereby repealed annulled and made void.

CHAPTER 143.

An act to incorporate a company for the purpose of building a bridge over the river Susquehannah, near Rock-run.

Passed Decr. 24, 1812.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John Creswell, Samuel C. Hall and Lawrence M'Comb, of Cecil county; John Stump, Junr. John Archer and James Stevenson, of Harford county, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or a majority of them are hereby required and directed, as soon as may be after the passage of this act, to proceed to the river Susquehannah and fix upon a scite for a bridge at such point on said river, at or near the head of the tide water, or Keer's Island near Rock-run, as to them shall appear most proper, and the said commissioners or a majority of them shall, as soon as they
