their road to or begin at George-Town in the district of Columbia, and to make the road within the said district in the same manner and on the same terms as they are authorised to do in the State of Maryland, and with power to erect a toll gate on said road within two miles of George-Town, and there to receive the tolls authorised and established by this law, when, and so soon as the said road shall be made and completed through Tenny Town as far as Montgomery Court House.



CHAPTER 150.

Passed Dec. 28, 1812. *An act for the support of William M. Chaney, of Anne-Arundel county.*

Preamble.

WHEREAS, William M. Chaney of Anne-Arundel county, by his petition to this General Assembly hath set forth, that he is old and is much afflicted with bodily infirmities incident to old age, which has rendered him unable to provide for himself and a large family a sufficient support, and praying an act may pass to provide for his maintenance; and the facts stated in said petition appearing true: *Therefore,*

A sum to be levied for his support.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Anne-Arundel county shall, and they are hereby empowered at their next levy court, and at their levy court annually during the life of the said William M. Chaney, to levy on the assessable property of said county, the sum of thirty dollars for the support of the said William M. Chaney, and the same when collected shall be paid by the collector of said county to William M. Chaney or order, for the purpose aforesaid.



CHAPTER 151.

Passed Dec. 28, 1812.

A sum may be levied for her support.

*An act for the relief of Alice Craycroft.*

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Anne Arundel county be, and they are hereby authorised and directed at their meeting for the purpose of laying their county levy, to assess and levy annually, so long as the same shall be necessary, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, on the assessable property of the said county, for the support and maintenance of the aforesaid Alice Craycroft, to be collected as other county charges are, and paid to the said Alice Craycroft or her order.
