

CHAPTER 33.

1812.

*A supplement to an act entitled, "An act to empower Rebecca Candler and John Candler, administrators of William Candler, late sheriff and collector of Montgomery county, to collect fees and county taxes put into his hands for collection during his life time.*

Passed Dec. 4, 1812.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Rebecca Candler and John Candler, or any person employed by them. be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at any time previous to the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, to proceed and collect by execution, (if necessary,) the county tax and officers' fees, for the year one thousand eight hundred and ten, and the officers' fees for the year one thousand eight hundred and eleven, (which were put into the hands of the said William Candler, late sheriff and collector of the county aforesaid, in the said years, for collection,) in the same manner as the said William Candler could have done, and to be entitled to receive the same fees in every case where they may be compelled to distrain for any of the said officers' fees and county tax, as the said William Candler would have been entitled to receive for similar services as collector and sheriff aforesaid.

Collection extended to Jan. 1, 1814.

CHAPTER 34.

*An act for extending Green-street, in the city of Baltimore.*

Passed Dec. 4, 1812.

WHEREAS, It is represented to this General Assembly, by a number of the inhabitants of the city of Baltimore, that their convenience would be very materially promoted by extending Green street in said city, and the said petition appearing reasonable and just; *Therefore,*

Preamble.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the city commissioners be, and they are hereby empowered to extend Green-street in the said city, forty feet in breadth from Pitt-street to Great York street, so as to open a communication between said Green-street and Exeter-street, commencing nearly opposite the south end of Green-street, and ending nearly opposite the north end of Exeter-street; and the said street when so opened and extended, and the valuation and assessment herein after directed to be made shall have taken

City commissioners empowered to extend said street—its width & direction—a plot to be returned and filed.
