AND BE IT ENACTED, That the stockholders in said company shall be, and they are hereby nities and adincorporated and constituted a body politic, by the vantages. name of the President, Managers and Company of the Cumber and Turnpike Road, & by the same name the said subscribers, and their successors, shall have succession during the continuance of this incorporation, and shall be and hereby are invested and clothed with all and singular the privileges, rights, immunities and advantages, held, used and possessed, by the several turnpike companies incorporated by an act passed at November session eighteen hundred and four, chapter fifty-one, entitled, "An act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes," to be governed by the several regulations and restrictions as are therein, entitled to the same tolls, adopting the same times and periods as to the election of their managers, president and officers.
